

Mischief 2017 Student Competition Application Form

General Information

If you've ever wanted to show off your pole skills in front of an audience then this could be the opportunity for you. Pole Princess is hosting the return of the annual 'Mischief' Student Competition on Friday 25th of August. Mischief will be held at The Eureka Hotel, (1 Church St, Richmond) & finalists in each category are limited so make sure you get your video entry in nice & early!

The competition offers the winners a wealth of prizes and a trophy for your mantle piece! Now is the time to apply!

YOU MAY NOT ENTER IN A LEVEL BELOW YOUR CURRENT SKILL!

Entry Requirements

Please send ONE email with all the following information completed within the same email. Incomplete entries will not be considered

- Fill in the following form – one per category you wish to enter. Both members of a doubles team need to fill out one form each.
- Enclose a photo of yourself in a pole trick or pose. If doubles, the photo must be one photo of the both of you together.
- Pay the entry fee via the PayPal link below. Entry fee is one fee per category you are entering. Doubles team only need to submit one payment as the payment is per video entry, not per person
- Prepare a maximum 3 minute max video entry of your planned show.
- After paying the entry fee, email the application form, your photo & video entry via an unlisted youtube or vimeo link to events@poleprincess.com.au by the deadline. Make sure your link is UNLISTED not PRIVATE as we won't be able to open private videos. If you password protect it, be sure to include the password along with the link in your entry email.

IMPORTANT: If paying from a PayPal account that is NOT in the same name you've put on your entry form, please include your PayPal name/email in the entry email when submitting all your information.

Categories

Miss Vixen Princess (Beginners): This category is suitable for students who are enrolled in a Level One or Two course but not yet progressed to Level Three at any Pole Princess Studio at the time of the competition. No tricks above Level Two standard are allowed in this category.

Miss Honey Princess (Intermediate): This category is suitable for students who are enrolled in a Level Three or Four course but not yet progressed to Level Five at any Pole Princess Studio at the time of the competition. All tricks up to a Level Four standard are allowed in this category.

Miss Foxy Princess (Advanced): This category is suitable for students who are enrolled in a Level Five or Six course but not yet progressed to Level Seven at any Pole Princess Studio at the time of the competition. All tricks up to a Level Six standard are allowed in this category.

Miss Queen of the Pole (Elite):

This category is suitable for students who are enrolled in a Level Seven course at the time of the competition. All tricks in the Pole Princess syllabus (or your own) are allowed in this category.

Doubles Princess: This category is for students wishing to compete with a friend. It is open to all levels and the major judging criteria for this category is choreography and synchronisation NOT pole tricks. Both people must be enrolled in an 8-week course at Pole Princess at the time of the competition in order to be eligible.

Miss Dirty Princess: This category is for all those dancers out there that would like to compete without using the pole. Anything goes in this category! You can choose from burlesque, floor work, acro or whatever your heart desires! You must be enrolled in an 8-week course at the time of the competition.

Further explanation

Students are encouraged to be creative. Variations of the tricks used in our syllabus are allowed & encouraged however, if a trick that is well known to our syllabus is used in a level higher than your category, it must be left out. If you wish to get creative with tricks and are unsure if something you want to use is in a level higher than what you've entered, we recommend booking a one hour private a few weeks out from the competition to have your routine checked with a teacher.

Please note that tricks used in entry videos are not checked to make sure they are the correct level, we are only judging based on your show as a whole. It is your responsibility to make sure you are only including tricks that fall within the criteria.

Eligibility

Mischief is a Social Competition under the Social Amateur level 1, 2, & 3. It is open to anyone that has NOT yet competed in an Australia Graded Competition. For clarification, please see <http://www.auspoledancersmag.com.au/competition-eligibility/>

There will be one pole only on stage.

Rules and Regulations for Mischief Student Competition 2017

Note: In the document below “Mischief Student Competition” and “Pole Princess Pty Ltd” refers to the owner of Pole Princess, Anastacia Snelleks, Melbourne & all it’s franchisors.

1) For selection, candidates may participate if they meet the following criteria:

- a. The candidate is enrolled in full in an 8-week course at any Pole Princess studio for Term 4, 2017
- b. The candidate must be at least 18 years of age and can be male or female
- c. The candidate is an Australian or New Zealand citizen

2) Registration may only be submitted by the participant

3) Participation in the Mischief Student Competition requires receipt of the accompanying registration form, payment of the entry fee and close adherence to the remaining conditions outlined below:

- a. The candidate declares that she has no contracts or obligations by other organisations or persons related to pole dancing.
- b. The registration form must be completed in full in accordance with these rules, dated and signed.
- c. A recent photo should be enclosed as well

4) Stipulations on Film and Photography

- a. All photography and other footage remain the property of Pole Princess Pty Ltd. The candidates have no right to compensation for photography and other footage made before, during and after the Mischief Student Competition 2017 event
- b. The candidate explicitly and irrevocably agrees that all footage and photography can be used by Pole Princess Pty Ltd for promotional, advertising and commercial purposes

5) Regarding Pole Dancing

- a. The candidate is skilled in pole dancing up to but not above the category they have entered.
- b. The candidate may choose the music for her show.
- c. A pole dance show is between:
 - i. 2-3 mins for The Vixen Princess category
 - ii. 3-4 mins for The Honey Princess category
 - iii. 4-5 mins for The Foxy Princess and Queen of the Pole categories
 - iv. 3-5 mins for The Doubles Princess category
 - v. 3-4 mins for The Dirty Princess category
- d. During the show, the candidate may not converse with the audience.
- e. It is forbidden to perform the show nude or partially nude. Exposed G-strings are forbidden. It is fine to remove articles of clothing/costume as long as you understand that this is not an R rated event!
- f. Any failure to abide by the above-mentioned rules will result in immediate disqualification.

6) Regarding Presentation/Costume

- a. All foot wear is allowed
- b. You may use props but this must be signed off by the organizer for safety reasons only. Please keep them small as we don’t have a side stage area
- c. No back up dancers or other people on stage
- d. Costumes are worth 5 in the judging criteria. It is important that as you are putting a “show” together the costume is fabulous.

7) Regarding doubles division

- a. If entering doubles division either partner may enter singles division as well
- b. The Title “Miss Pole Princess Doubles Division Winner 2017” is valid for one year for both partners
- c. Show must be between 3 and 5 minutes long
- d. Each contestant in the doubles team needs to fill out an entry form and enter at the same time but pay only one entry fee between them
- e. Division will be judged on:
 - 10 points: Choreography – How well the routine performed matches the song chosen along with the coordination of the tricks
 - 10 points: Pole Work – The technique of each contestant along with the synchronicity of the tricks
 - 5 points: Costuming – Attention to detail along with physical presentation

8) Regarding the Competition:

- a. Applications must be completed & submitted along with a video entry & payment of the entry fee. Incomplete entries will not be considered. Videos longer than 3 minutes will not be viewed after the 3 minute mark. Your video entry can still be a work in progress but it must clearly display your theme intended. If you are unsuccessful as a finalist for your category, you may still have a chance to get in if a successful applicant drops out.
- b. The winners of each category will hold their title for one year
- c. During the competition, the candidates must abide by the rules and arrive in advance as stated by the organiser
- e. An expert jury will judge the candidates on the basis of pole work (10), choreography (10), and costume (5). The winner will be the person that can execute the best pole moves of their level with the best technique and put it into the best show including attention to costume
- f. Candidates may not communicate with members of the judging panel before, during or after the competition.
- g. Pole Princess Pty Ltd reserves the right to expel a candidate from participation, both before and during the competition.
- h. The finalists must be available for a photo shoot throughout the night.
- i. Pole Princess Pty Ltd expects the prize winners to cooperate with the promotion of the Mischief Student Competition and activities.
- j. Dressing rooms are off limits to family members or friends of the candidates.
- k. Contestants are not allowed to drink alcohol (or take drugs) before their show

9) Regarding the Title "Miss Vixen Princess", "Miss Honey Princess", "Miss Foxy Princess", "Miss Queen of the Pole", "The Double Princess" and "Miss Dirty Princess"

- a. The titles are official titles valid for one year.
- b. As "Miss Vixen Princess", "Miss Honey Princess", "Miss Foxy Princess", "Miss Queen of the Pole", "The Double Princess" and "Miss Dirty Princess" the winner is an ambassador of pole dancing and a representative of Pole Princess Pty Ltd.
- c. The Organisation reserves the right to retract the title if the winner causes any damages to the Miss Pole Princess Student Competition or Pole Princess Pty Ltd.
- f. In the case of retraction, the runner-up becomes the new holder of the title for their category.

10) Regarding the Competition Owners

- a. Pole Princess Pty Ltd & its franchisors are never liable for injury or damage resulting from participation in the Mischief Student Competition.
- b. The Organisation reserves the right to change the rules contained herein.
- c. All decisions not addressed in these regulations will be made by Mischief Student Competition owners.
- d. A decision made by the Mischief Student Competition is binding.
